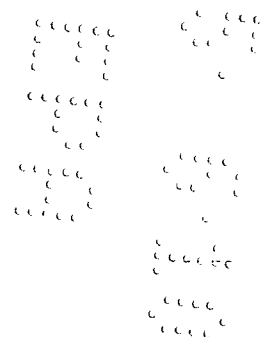

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food/feed processing, preparation, or food/feed storage or serving areas. In the home, all food/feed processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use following treatment. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes, or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. Foliage of plants that are contacted with spray should be hosed off.

This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and check for staining in a few hours.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Do not make applications during the rain.

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

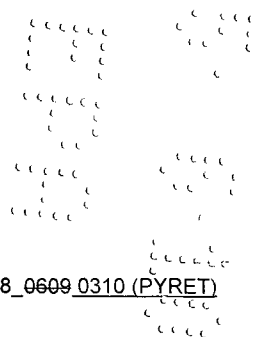
- (1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures;
- (2) Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation;
- (3) Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet.

Other than application to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

For Control of Nests of Wasp and Hornets: The best time to spray the nest is in the early morning or early evening, when air temperature is cooler, most insects are in the nest, and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if the air is still.

Stand at a safe distance from the nest, not directly under it. Hold container upright at arms length, point the actuator at the nest. If nest has visible entrances, first spray into these openings and then soak the remainder of the nest. Treated insects may fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the nest after treatment will be killed. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling

Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

If empty:

Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled:

Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
