EVERCIDE® Emulsifiable Concentrate 2806 is designed for repackaging or formulating with deionized water to produce insecticide sprays. Formulators who use this product may be responsible for providing data to support their own registrations with the appropriate regulatory agencies. Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a warm, dry place. Keep container closed.

<u>PESTICIDE DISPOSAL</u>: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
