ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product

in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

OUTDOOR USES: Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas, and outdoor play areas.

INDOOR USES: Attics, and anywhere nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed.

Kills insects and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying. Kills any insects inside the nest as well as any returning.

For Control of Wasps, Yellow Jackets, and Hornets and other listed insects:

For Nests:

1. Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active.
2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath.
3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray.
4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked.
5. Next spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.
6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies and Mosquitos:

1. Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed.
2. To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges.

Use Tips:

1. If windy, stand with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift.
2. Avoid directly spraying vegetation.
3. Foliage of desirable plants that were contacted with spray should be hosed off.

General Precautions & Restrictions:

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in commercial food/feed processing, preparation, food/feed storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.
