CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical resistant gloves.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of aerosol unit. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and requirements.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the area.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product around electrical equipment due to possibility of shock hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

General Precautions & Restrictions:

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where food is served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Do not apply when food is present. Exposed food should be covered or removed. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums and ornamental fish ponds before spraying and turn aquarium systems off.

Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift.

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- (1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures; and,
- (2) Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet.

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as window, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and crevice, applications only.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Do not make applications during rain.

Use Precautions:

- Avoid spraying desirable plants. Rinse with water any desirable foliage that is contacted with spray.
- 2. This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

OUTDOOR USES: Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas, and outdoor play areas.

INDOOR USES: Attics, and anywhere nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed.

Kills insects and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying. Kills any insects inside the nest as well as any returning.

For Control Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Hornets, and other listed insects:

For Nests:

- 1. Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active.
- 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath.
- 3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray.
- 4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked.
- 5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.
- Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes:

- Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects
 are noticed.
- 2. To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges.

Kills Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Mud Daubers, and Hornets:

To treat nests:

- 1. Spray at sunrise or dusk when insects are least active.
- 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath
- 3. Always hold can upright while spraying.
- 4. With wind at your back, aim actuator [trigger] at the nest, and push button to spray.
- 5. Spray opening of nest until soaked. Then spray the rest of the nest.
- 6. Entrapping [jet] foam will remain on the nest to kill insects that return to the nest.
- 7. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

Kills other insects, including Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes:

- 1. Spray short 1-2 second bursts directly on insects.
- 2. For scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover the insect. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

Use Tips:

- 1. If windy, stand with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift.
- 2. Avoid spraying vegetation directly
- 3. Rinse with water any desirable foliage that is contacted with spray.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.
