The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Tetramethrin and Phenothrin Interim Decisions, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of aerosol unit. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and requirements.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

#### **General Precautions & Restrictions:**

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where food is served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Do not apply when food is present. Exposed food should be covered or removed. All food preparation surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums and ornamental fishponds before spraying and turn aquarium systems off.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, Directions for Use except for the following permitted uses:

- 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- 2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
- 3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure:
- 4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- 5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level:
- 6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.

Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Do not make applications during rain. Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

Use Precautions:

- 1. Avoid spraying desirable plants. Rinse with water any desirable foliage that is contacted with spray.
- This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

OUTDOOR USES: Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas, and outdoor play areas.

INDOOR USES: Attics, and anywhere nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed.

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Kills insects and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying. Kills any insects inside the nest as well as any returning.

For Control of [To kill] Wasps, Yellowjackets, Mud Daubers, Hornets, and [to kill] other listed insects:

For Nests [To treat nests]:

- Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active.
- 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath.
- 3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray. [Aim actuator [trigger] at the nest, and push button to spray.]
- 4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked.
- 5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. [This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.] [Entrapping [jet] foam will remain on the nest to kill insects that return to the nest.]
- 6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.
- 7. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

TO KILL AND PREVENT Wasps, Hornets, Yellowjackets, Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes FROM ENTERING THE HOME OR LIVING AREA:

- Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed.
- 2. Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges.
- 3. Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff.
- 4. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

To kill listed pests, including Fire Ants, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes: Spray short 1 – 2 second bursts directly on insects. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

To kill scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover the scorpion. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

Use Tips

- 1. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.
- 2. Avoid spraying vegetation directly.
- 3. Rinse with water any desirable foliage that is contacted with spray.
