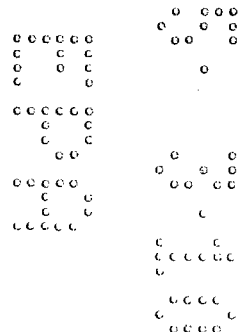

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.
Do not make applications during the rain.

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:
(1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures;
Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after applications.

OUTDOOR USES: Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas, and outdoor play areas.

INDOOR USES: Attics, anywhere nests are built, and where food or feed is not exposed.

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Kills insects and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying; kills any insects inside the nest as well as any returning.

For Control Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Hornets and other listed insects:

For Nests:

1. Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active.
2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath.
3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray.
4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked.
5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.
6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Scorpions, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes:

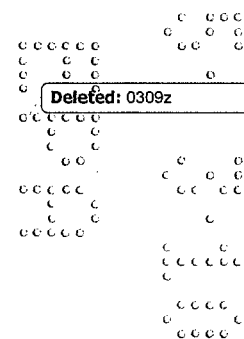
1. Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed.
2. To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges.

Use Tips:

1. If windy, stand with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift.
2. Avoid spraying vegetation directly
3. Foliage of desirable plants that were contacted with spray should be hosed off.

This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame, preferably in a locked storage area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling

Do not puncture or incinerate!
