- 5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.
- 6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Scorpions, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes:

- Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed.
- To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges. Do not apply more than one time per day to same surface.
