DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

OUTDOOR USES: Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas, and outdoor play areas.

INDOOR USES: Attics, and anywhere nests are built and where food or feed are not exposed.

Kills insects and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying. Kills any insects inside the nest as well as any returning.

For Control Wasps, Yellowjackets, and Hornets and other listed insects:

For Nests:

- Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active.
- 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath.
- 3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray.
- 4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked.
- 5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest.
- 6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellowiackets, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies and Mosquitoes:

 Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed.

To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges.

Use Tips:

- 1. If windy, stand with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift.
- Avoid spraying vegetation directly
- Foliage of desirable plants that were contacted with spray should be hosed off.

General Precautions & Restrictions:

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in commercial food/feed processing, preparation, food/feed storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
