The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

- Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a) Delete Non Flammable. As indicated in our previous letter it does not meet the criteria under item 1(b) of the Label Review Manual, i.e. flash point greater than 350 degrees fahrenheit (177 degrees Celsius) for the liquid portion of this formula. The MSDS for the propellant portion of the formula also recommends avoidance of open flame.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

# CAUTION

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

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Do not apply directly to food. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 [5,000] [4,000] [3,000] cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

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TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. [Break off and remove tab on side of sprayer]. Tilt sprayer away from face (container sprays straight up). Press down firmly on sprayer pad until it snaps into place.

<u>To Kill Fleas and Ticks</u>: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as directed above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Contents under pressure. Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame to prevent bursting of container.
