3. Close lid. Pull towel at 90° angle
4. Snap hinged cap back into place to ensure towels stay moist

Tear open envelope, remove towel; open, and wipe or rub liberally on all exposed skin areas avoiding eyes and mouth. Repeat when insects become annoying. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing. Repeat using a fresh towel when necessary.
