The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Esfenvalerate Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for

shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

EVERCIDE® Esfenvalerate 0.025% RTU CS is an effective formulation that kills crawling insects fast. It stays on treated surfaces and provides residual insect killing power for up to three months.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE

USE RESTRICTIONS

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Cover or remove exposed food/feed. People and pets should not be allowed in treated areas until spray has dried. Do not use this product on pets.

Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff.

Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Sprayer Instructions:

How to prime and care for your sprayer:

1. After vigorously shaking product, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.

2. Turn sprayer nozzle one half turn counter-clockwise. Hold sprayer below the level of container and prime by pumping trigger 10 to 15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to fine spray or jet stream as needed.
3. To store, turn nozzle to "off" position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Typical Areas That May Require Insecticide Treatment:

INDOORS:

Spray areas where Ants, Cockroaches, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Millipedes, Palmetto Bugs, Psocids, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Water Bugs are found or normally reside, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around plumbing and other utility installations.

For control of Carpet Beetles, thoroughly spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets, on shelving, and wherever else insects are seen or suspected.

Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: For control of Brown Dog Ticks, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. For control of Fleas, thoroughly apply a fine particle broadcast spray to infested rugs, carpets, and pet resting areas. Prior to treatment, aquariums and fish bowls should be covered and birds, such as canaries, removed from the area. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until the spray has dried. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. *Do not treat pets with this product.* To control the source of flea infestations, pets should be treated with a product registered for application to animals. Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

To kill Bed Bugs: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices, and around baseboards, floorboards, headboards, and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may harbor pests. On mattresses, concentrate on tufts, folds, and seams. Allow all areas to thoroughly dry before use. Cover mattress before use.

For Ants, apply to ant trails; around doors and windows; and wherever Ants may find entrance.

To kill Carpenter Ants: Use a coarse spray, around doors, doorframes, windows, and other areas where these ants enter the premises or hide. Spray into cracks and crevices through openings or small, newly drilled holes into wall voids where these ants or their nests are present.

Typical Areas That May Require Insecticide Treatment:

OUTDOORS:

GENERAL: Use EVERCIDE Esfenvalerate 0.025% RTU CS to control Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Ticks on contact. Apply to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages, grasses, and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

Take precautions to minimize spray drift.

For soil and foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds. .

Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes.

Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.

Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patio except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff. .Avoid soaking young or flowering plants.

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants

Flies and Mosquitoes: For outdoor use only as an aid in controlling these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever insects may enter the room. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures, on porches, in garages, and other places where insects alight or congregate.

Ants, Ticks (including ticks which may transmit Lyme disease), Crickets, Fleas, and Earwigs: For treatment of infestation of these insects in areas where there are weeds or bushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. When treating for Ticks, give special attention to areas frequented by pets. For Ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways.

Building Perimeter Treatment: To help prevent infestations of buildings by Ants, Crickets, Spiders, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs), treat a 12 to 18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, and their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with this application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
