3. Product specific efficacy data will be required. Once the efficacy guidelines are in place, you will be notified of the efficacy requirements.



Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overapplication of this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call you local Poison Control Center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you.

Hold container upright about 4 - 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not spray in enclosed areas. If used on face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes.
