Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

Marketing Claims section comment(s), page 1 of 2:

1. The words "insect repellent" must be revised in the product title. Specifically, the words "**INSECT REPELLENT**" must be displayed prominently on the front panel of this product label, immediately after the brand name in capital lettering with large, contrasting bold-face type.

First Aid section comment(s), page 1 of 2:

2. Revise the last statement in the table to read as follows:

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **For additional information on this pesticide product, you may call 1-888-740-8712 or the National Pesticide Information Center at 1-800-858-7378 for emergency medical treatment information.**"¹

Directions for Use section comment(s), page 2 of 2:

3. Replace the 2nd paragraph with the following:

"**Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.** Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not use as a face spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. Frequent reapplication and saturation of clothing are unnecessary for effectiveness. If used on the face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly on the face. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to

you own hands and then put it on the child. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Apply to clothing such as shirt, pants, hat and socks. Do not use under clothing. For Chiggers and Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs or socks."

- 4. Replace the 2nd sentence of the 4th paragraph with: "Wash treated clothing before wearing it again."

Storage and Disposal section comment(s), page 2 of 2:

- 5. Replace the existing section with the following:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool and dry area. Keep out of reach of children.

Pesticide Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.


Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, etc., or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

The product must be packaged in containers utilizing a **concave trigger to help aim product** or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
