Directions for Use section comment(s), page 1 of 2:

1. As required by PR Notice 2001-3, replace the 2nd paragraph with: "Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not use as a face spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and do not use it near food. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears. When using sprays, do not spray directly into face; spray on hands first and then apply to face. Do not allow children to handle this product, and do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on the child. Never use repellents over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Repellents should be applied only to exposed skin and/or clothing such as shirt, pants, hat and socks. Do not use under clothing. For Chiggers and Ticks, apply to shirt and pant cuffs or socks."

Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect a reaction to this product, discontinue use, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent product with you."

Storage and Disposal section comment(s), page 2 of 2:

3. Add the statement "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal." immediately following the section title "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL."

The product must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

McLaughlin Gormley King Company should note that the Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
