Dear Ms. Schlekau:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

Marketing Claims section comment(s):

In the 1st marketing claim, replace the word "cause" with the word "transmit."

In the 2nd marketing claim, replace the word "carry" with the word "transmit." 2.

Delete the 5th marketing claim. 3.

Revise the 11th marketing claim to read: "Repels Mosquitoes, Black Flies, Ticks, and Fleas" 4.

Directions for Use section comment(s):

At the end of the 14th sentence of the 2nd paragraph, replace the misspelled word "productc" with the word "product."

Replace paragraph 4 with:

"NOTE: Will not damage cotton, wool or nylon. Do not apply on or near acetate, rayon, Spandex or other synthetic fabrics (other than nylon), furniture, plastics (such as eyeglasses and watch crystals), leather and painted or varnished surfaces (including automobiles)."

The product must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in the eyes.

McLaughlin Gormley King Company should note that the Agency is in the process of developing and Improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised quidelines.

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.
