The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notices (PRN) 98-10 and 2007-4 dated February 10, 2009 for the product MGK[®] Pressurized Repellent Spray 2850 (EPA Registration Number 1021-1825). The Registration Division (RD) has conducted its review of this request for its applicability under PRNs 98-10 and 2007-4 and finds that the label changes requested fall within the scope of PRNs 98-10 and 2007-4. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on nonrefillable containers. The code may appear either on the label (and can be added by non-notification/PR Notice 98-10) or durably marked on the container itself.

[STOP] Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label. Hold container upright about 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing. Do not use as a face spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product and do not use it near food. Spray and spread evenly with your hand to moisten all exposed skin. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, and apply sparingly around ears.
