- d. Imiprothrin is not registered for use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments. Therefore delete the two paragraphs under As a Surface Spray since they pertain to use of this product in food/feed handling establishments.
 - e. Under Precautions add the following statements:

Hospital and/or nursing home patients must be removed from their rooms while treatment is being applied and must not be allowed to return until all treated surfaces have dried.

Do not apply this pesticide when classrooms are in use.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared food is served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Non food areas of restaurants or food handling establishments are areas including (but not limited to) garage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine room, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning and bottling).

- f. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read as follows: This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic organism. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes.".
- g. The directions for ants, ticks are mixed in under the heading Flies and Mosquitoes. Make this a separate paragraph under the correct heading.
- h. The cited and submitted data supports the claim for German cockroaches only. General cockroach claims require the submission of corroborative data for at least two species of cockroach (one large species and one small species). Either submit or cite data for one species of large cockroach (American or Oriental cockroach) or qualify cockroaches with the species (German) on the label.

- i. The following pests are supported by previous data: Ants, including Carpenter Ants; Flies; Mosquitoes; Spiders; Fleas (adult and pre- adult fleas and eggs (2 months)); and Ticks (including ticks which may transmit Lyme Disease.
- j. Please update your data matrix to cite MRID 46387001 as supporting your efficacy claims.
- k. We recommend you modify the product name since it implies home use whereas the product is also used at non-residential sites.

Sprayer Instructions:

How to prime and care for your sprayer:

- 1. After shaking product well, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.
- 2. Turn sprayer nozzle one half turn counter-clockwise. Hold sprayer below the level of container and prime by pumping trigger 10-15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to fine spray or jet stream as needed.
- 3. To store, turn nozzle to "off" position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

Typical Areas That May Require Insecticide Treatment:

NDOORS:

Spray areas where Cockroaches, Palmetto Bugs, Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Firebrats, Water Bugs, Silverfish, and Spiders are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around plumbing and other utility installations. For Ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever ants may find entrance. For control of Carpet Beetles, thoroughly spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting; under carpeting, rugs and furniture; in closets; on shelving; and wherever else insects are seen or suspected. For control of Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks, thoroughly spray pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window, and door frames; and localized areas of floors and floor coverings where Fleas and Ticks may be present. Pet bedding should be replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treating the area. Do not treat pets with this product. To control the source of flea infestations, pets should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.

AS A SURFACE SPRAY: Use at a rate of one (1) gallon of spray per 1,000 square feet.

To Kill the Accessible Stages of Granary Insects: Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Rust Red Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Cadelles, Meal Moth Larvae and Adults, Cigarette Beetles, Drug Store Beetles, and Granary Weevils: Apply as a coarse, wet spray to surfaces where these pests are normally found, such as on floors and around baseboards, walls, benches, and pieces of equipment. Pay particular attention to cracks, crevices, and similar protected locations in floors and walls. Spray thoroughly around and into floor drains, non-food conveyors, and other areas where granary insects may be found. Do not apply when food processing facility is in operation or foods are exposed. Do not apply this spray to surfaces or utensils that may come into contact with food; excessive residues in food may result.

Do Not Exceed More Than One Application Every Fourteen (14) Days.

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Psocids, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Waterbugs: Apply this spray with a sprayer that produces coarse, wetting droplets into all cracks and crevices in woodwork and floors, underneath sinks, areas behind pipes, and in all places where these insects shelter. Directly spray as many insects as possible. Do not exceed more than one application every seven (7) days in restaurants and similar food service establishments or more than one application every fourteen (14) days in all types of food handling establishments.

FOR PREMISE PESTS: Use at the rate of one (1) gallon of spray per 1,000 square feet.

Application Within Residential and Non-Residential Buildings Including Homes, Apartment Buildings, Kennels, and Non-Food Areas of Industrial, Institutional, and Commercial Buildings such as Hospitals, Hotels, Warehouses, Truck Trailers, Railroad Cars, Theatres, Office Buildings, and Schools.

GENERAL: Apply as a coarse, wet spray to thoroughly treat hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas around pipes, under refrigerators, and along baseboards to control pests listed below. Use at the rate of one (1) gallon of spray mixture per 1,000 square feet. Spray directly on insects when possible. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until the spray has dried. Do not treat establishments where livestock feed is present.

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Psocids, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Waterbugs:

Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For Ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever these pests may find entrance.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: For Control of Brown Dog Ticks, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames; and localized areas of floors and floor coverings where these pests may be present. For control of Fleas, thoroughly apply a fine particle broadcast spray to infested rugs, carpets, and pet resting areas. Prior to treatment, aquariums and fish bowls should be covered, and birds, such as canaries, should be removed from the area. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Treat dogs and cats with a product registered for use on animals. Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

To Kill Bedbugs: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices and around baseboards, floorboards, headboards, and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may harbor pests. On mattresses, concentrate on tufts, folds, and seams.

To Kill Carpenter Ants: Use a coarse spray around doors, doorframes, windows, and other areas where these ants enter the premises or hide. Spray into cracks and crevices, through openings or small, newly-drilled holes into wall voids where these ants or their nests are present.

<u>Flies and Mosquitoes</u>: For outdoor use only as an aid in controlling these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever insects may enter the room. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures, on porches, in garages, and other places where insects alight or congregate. Repeat as needed. Ants, Ticks (including ticks which transmit Lyme disease), Crickets, Fleas, and Earwigs: For treatment of infestation of these insects in areas where there are weeds or bushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. When treating for ticks, give special attention to areas frequented by pets. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, and their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with this application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
