- b. On the front panel delete "for complete kill" in the bullet "Coats nests for complete kill" and "Kills (the) entire nest". As we indicated previously 100% efficacy claims are not acceptable.
  - c. Delete the pests carpenter ants and ticks. The data referred under EPA Reg. No. 1021-1798 are not acceptable since the cited product is dissimilar in formulation to the subject product. Also the test formulations containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide were higher than those tested for this formulation.
  - d. Based on the acute oral toxicity study used in support of this product you may delete the If Swallowed first aid statement.
3. Submit to the Agency, data on one year storage stability testing (830.6317), conducted concurrently with the corrosion characteristics study (830-6320) at 0, 3, 6, 9 and 12 months of warehouse storage.
  4. Submit two (2) copies of the final printed label before releasing this product for shipment.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE**

Kills Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Mud Daubers and Hornets:

To treat nests:

1. Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active.
2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath or above nest.
3. Shake can well before each use. Always hold can upright while spraying.
4. With wind at your back, aim nozzle at nest and spray until soaked.
5. Wait 24 hours before removing the nest.

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Kills other insects, including Spiders (including Black Widows), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants (including carpenter ants but excluding fire ants and harvester ants), Ticks, Centipedes and Earwigs:

1. Spray 1 - 2 second bursts directly on insects.
2. For scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover the insect. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

**Use Precautions:**

1. Avoid spraying plants. Rinse any foliage that is contacted with water.
2. This product is non-staining to most home siding and shingles, depending on age and cleanliness. Before using in areas where product may come in contact with home surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area first and observe for staining potential.
3. Do not use this product around electrical equipment or outlets because of possible shock hazard.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame, preferably in a locked storage area.

**DISPOSAL:**
