CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash waters or rinsate.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product around electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff.

Do not make applications during the rain.

All outdoor applications, are limited to building surfaces and spot treatments on structures.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storms drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after applications.

Kills Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Mud Daubers and Hornets:

To treat nests:

- 1. Outdoor use is restricted to nests on building surfaces or structures.
- 2. Spray at sunrise or sunset [dusk] when insects are least active.
- 3. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath or above nest.
- 4. Shake can well before each use. Always hold can upright while spraying.
- 5. With wind at your back, aim nozzle at nest and spray until soaked.
- 6. Wait 24 hours before removing the nest.

Kills other insects, including Spiders (including Black Widows), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants (excluding carpenter ants, fire ants and harvester ants), Centipedes and Earwigs:

- 1. Spray 1–2 second bursts directly on insects.
- 2. For scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover the insect. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

Use Precautions:

- 1. Avoid spraying plants. Rinse any foliage that is contacted with water.
- This product is non-staining to most home siding and shingles, depending on age and cleanliness. Before using in areas where product may come in contact with home surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area first and observe for staining potential.
- 3. Do not use this product around electrical equipment or outlets because of possible shock hazard.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling
