#### CAUTION

- Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.
- THIS PRODUCT IS FOR LIMITED OUTDOOR RESIDENTIAL APPLICATION TO BUILDING SURFACES AND PERIMETERS (SPOT TREATMENTS) ON STRUCTURES ONLY.
- Do not make applications during rain.
- . Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- All outdoor applications, if permitted elsewhere on this label, must be limited to spot or crack and crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses, if allowed elsewhere on this label: (1) Applications to the side of a building, up to a maximum of 3 feet above grade; (2) Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure; and (3) Applications around potential pest entry points into buildings, when limited to a surface band not to exceed one inch in width.

#### Kills Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Mud Daubers and Hornets:

#### To treat nests:

- 1. Spray at sunrise or sunset [dusk] when insects are least active.
- 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath or above nest.
- 3. Shake can well before each use. Always hold can upright while spraying.
- 4. With wind at your back, aim nozzle at nest and spray until soaked.
- 5. Wait 24 hours before removing the nest.

Kills other insects, including Spiders (including Black Widows), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants (excluding carpenter ants, fire ants and harvester ants), Centipedes and Earwigs:

1. Spray 1 - 2 second bursts directly on insects.

2. For scorpions, stand 3-4 feet away and thoroughly cover the insect. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

**Pesticide Storage** 

Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use. Store this product in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place away from food and pet food, and in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals.
