The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Esfenvalerate Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for

shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

CAUTION

USE RESTRICTIONS

- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.
- THIS PRODUCT IS FOR LIMITED OUTDOOR RESIDENTIAL APPLICATION TO BUILDING SURFACES AND PERIMETERS (SPOT TREATMENTS) ON STRUCTURES ONLY.
- Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).
- Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.
- Do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.
- Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes.
- Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur

- Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment
- Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:
 - 1. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
 - 2. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
 - 3. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- Avoid spraying plants. Rinse any foliage with water that is contacted by this product.
- Do not use this product around electrical equipment or outlets because of possible shock hazard.
- This product is non-staining to most home siding and shingles, depending on age and cleanliness. Before using in areas where product may come in contact with home surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area first and observe for staining potential.
- Application of this product is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow to enter indoor or outdoor drains. No permita la entrada a desagües internos o externos
- Take precautions to minimize spray drift.
- Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

- Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Kills Wasps, Yellowjackets, Mud Daubers and Hornets:

To treat nests:

1. Spray at sunrise or sunset [dusk] when insects are least active.
2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath or above nest.
3. Shake can well before each use. Always hold can upright while spraying.
4. With wind at your back, aim nozzle at nest and spray until soaked.
5. Wait 24 hours before removing the nest.

Kills other insects, including Spiders (including Black Widows), Scorpions, Crickets, Ants (excluding carpenter ants, fire ants and harvester ants), Centipedes and Earwigs:

1. Spray 1 to 2 second bursts directly on insects.
2. For scorpions, stand 3 to 4 feet away and thoroughly cover the insect. Make sure scorpions are dead before removing.

Crack and Crevice Treatments: Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
