On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), since you agreed in your letter dated October 27, 2004 that:

1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Registration Number 1021-1855."

b. You may delete the "If In Eyes" section under First Aid section since the toxicity category does not require this statement.

c. Change Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to read "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap or water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."

d. On the front panel delete "Kills on contact", "Fast Knockdown and kill", "Long Lasting", "Fastest Black Flag", and "Kills on contact". These claims are not supported by the data.

e. Delete "fire ants", palmetto bugs", "waterbugs" and brown dog ticks" These claims are not supported by the data.

f. Modify "cockroaches" to read "cockroaches (German cockroaches)".

g. On page 2 delete paragraph 2. Only knockdown and kill claims were supported by data.

h. On page 2 delete "For ants, apply to ant trails and wherever ants may find entrance.". This residual claim is not supported by the data.

i. On the front panel revise "For Indoor Use" to read "For Indoor Household Use Only".

j. "Other Ingredients" must be aligned to the same margin and have the same type size as active ingredients.

k. Delete EPA Registration Number 1021-1691.

l. Add "Do not use as a space spray." and "All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use."

m. Delete all references to scent on the front panel. There are no fragrances in the formulations.

1. Spray directly on insects for immediate kill.
