On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

b. Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals move "Causes moderate eye irritation." after "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin."

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c. Add a referral statement to front panel, i.e., "Refer to back side panels for additional precautions."

d. On the front panel add, "For Indoor Residential Use Only."

e. Delete Fire Ants, Cockroaches (General claim, large species and Palmetto bugs), and ticks (Brown Dog Ticks and General Tick Claims). Since the data submitted do not support these pests.

f. Remove all control claims. Only kill claims are supported.

g. Remove all references to "long-lasting" or other residual claims. The data submitted do not support residual claims.

h. Remove all immediate, quick, or fast claims. Only know down claims are supported.

i. Remove directions for use that indicate that this product may be used in a manner other than a direct contact insecticide.

j. Either delete the statement, "Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas or change to, "Do not use in food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other sites where food is commercially prepared, processed or stored."

k. Under Directions for Use add, "Do not use as a space spray."

CRACK AND CREVICE SPRAY: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Pay special attention to areas such as behind baseboards, connection areas around drains and pipes, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, and plumbing, and other visible cracks and crevices. Spray these areas thoroughly; making certain that spray penetrates well.

CONTACT APPLICATION: Spray at the rate of one liter per second. Contact as many insects as possible with this spray, in addition to thoroughly spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Pay special attention to hiding places such as beneath sinks, behind and beneath stoves and refrigerators, around garbage cans and cabinets, along

the outside of baseboards, sills, frames and floors, around and on drains, pipes and plumbing, behind bookcases, storage, and other utility installation areas, contacting insects with spray when possible.

Carpet Beetles [Dermestids (Trogoderna): Directly spray as many insects as possible. Where possible, bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, on floors and walls, around windowsills and baseboards, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Backing of carpets and rugs should be allowed to dry before re-laying on floor.

Foraging Ants, Fire Ants and Foraging Carpenter Ants: To kill foraging Ants, including Fire Ants and Carpenter Ants spray insects directly and ant trails.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly spray, as a spot treatment, infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas. Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

To Kill Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Palmetto Bugs, Asian Lady Bird Beetles, Crickets, Scorpions, Silverfish and Sowbugs: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing, and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly.
