d. On the front panel change "Waterproof formula" to "Water resistant formula".

e. Under "To control Fleas and Ticks (Adult and Larvae) [on dog premises]: add "Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after treatment. Allow to dry thoroughly before allowing pets to contact treated areas."

f. The word "new" may be used on the labeling for a period of six months following initial marketing of this product.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. This product is not for use on humans.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

Sprayer Instructions: How to prime and care for your sprayer:

1. After shaking product well, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.
2. Turn sprayer nozzle one-half turn counter-clockwise. Hold sprayer below the level of the container and prime by pumping trigger 10-15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to fine spray or jet stream as needed.
3. To store, turn nozzle to "off" position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.

Protects Horses and Ponies from attacks of Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Face Flies, Deer Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats. Do not use on foals under 3 months of age.

To Protect Horses and Ponies from attacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats. Spray on each side being careful to spray back withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect for Face Flies spray the face and head but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome. Wipe-On: Remove excess dust and dirt. Spray product on clean cloth and wipe animal, being careful to treat back, withers, and forelegs. To protect from face flies, apply to face and head but avoid contact with eyes.

To Treat Livestock: To protect beef cattle, dairy cattle, goats, sheep, hogs and horses from attacks of Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Face Flies, House Flies, Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats. Spray on each side of animal being careful to spray back withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from Face Flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray into eyes. Repeat treatment when flies are troublesome.

For Swine: Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

To control Blood Sucking Lice: Apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 3 weeks if required.

To control Poultry Lice, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly, followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

For control of Bedbugs and Mites in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.

FOR PETS: USE ONLY ON DOGS, HORSES, AND PONIES

DO NOT USE ON PUPPIES UNDER TWELVE WEEKS

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant, or nursing animals.

To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice on dogs: Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to ensure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Do not spray directly in/on eyes, mouth, or genitalia of pets. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control infestations.

To control Fleas and Ticks (Adults and Larvae) [on dog premises]: Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor, and floor covering with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

To kill Lice and Louse Eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, and then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use. Do not treat blankets, sheets, pillows, pillow cases or mattress covers.
