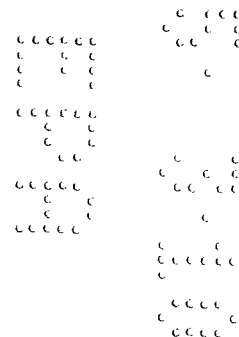

General Precautions and Use Restrictions:

Cover or remove exposed food, all food processing surfaces and utensils before treatment or thoroughly wash before use following treatment. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not use in indoor metered spray systems.

Do not use in automatic misting systems.

Kills many flying insects including: Flies, houseflies, cluster flies, face flies, vinegar flies, fruit flies, and other biting flies, mosquitoes, gnats, and small flying moths.

INDOORS:

Close doors and windows. Direct spray upward to center of room, using slow, sweeping motion. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially near light sources. In kitchens, treat areas that attract insects such as window screens and around windows, sinks, garbage cans. Keep spray away from walls, drapes, and furniture. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Do not remain in treated area. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

OUTDOORS:

Remove all exposed food and cooking utensils. Cover all food-handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment and before use following treatment. Do not use on edible crops.

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Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Do not make applications during rain.

All out door applications must be limited to spot or crack-and crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

(1) Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures;

(2) Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation;

(3) Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet.

Other than applications to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only.

Do not apply directly to sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur, except as directed by this label.

To kill [reduce annoyance] of these insects, spray when air is calm using slow, sweeping motion. If a slight breeze is present, spray with the wind. Allow fog to drift over treated area. Spray around porches, patios, screens, doors, window frames and screens, and garbage cans. If spraying around growing plants, keep spray at least 24 inches from foliage to avoid plant injury. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.
