

Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear protective eyewear such as goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

User Safety Recommendations

Delete the following claims which detract from the Precautionary statements and directions for use:

Just turn on the propane and push!
Most yards can be treated in a matter of minutes.

All references to propane or propane powered must state that the propane is sold separately.

Qualify the statement "Can be used with all portable propane tanks" to agree with limitations stated in the user manual.

Revise the statement about indoor use to read as follows:
Do not use indoors or in enclosed spaces.

Revise the statement for homeowner use only to read:
For outdoor residential use only.

Delete "campgrounds," "picnic areas", "campsites, "camping" "and other areas" from the label and user manual.

Revise references to "large areas" to read "large areas around your home"

Revise the Storage and Disposal statements to add instructions for storage and disposal of the fogging device. The user manual must conform to these statements.

Add to the Directions for Use under a subsection entitled General Precautions and Restrictions the following statements.

- Do not allow adults, children or pets to enter until vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets either directly or through drift.
- Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors and /or mists have dispersed.
- Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.
- Do not apply directly to or near water, storm drains, or drainage ditches. Do not apply when windy. To prevent product run-off, do not over water the treated areas or apply prior to heavy rainfall.
- Do not apply more than 1 time per day.

References to events where food is likely to be present must be qualified by the statement "Cover or remove exposed food and drinking water before application."

Revise the Environmental Hazards statements to read as follows:

This product is toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to fish in waters adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment, washer or rinsate. See directions for use for additional precautions and requirements.

As the formulation is a liquid, the application rate must be expressed in terms of fluid ounces of product per 1000 sq. ft., not ounces per 1000 sq. ft.

Revise the directions for use on shrubs to include the following:

Do not wet plants to point of runoff or drip.

In the user manual, delete the references to "recommended" and "to obtain the most effective fog" when referring to the pumping/squeezing the trigger rate, as these phrases detract from the directions for use.

In the directions for use, clarify whether the fogging is achieved by squeezing the trigger, pumping the fogger or pumping the trigger.

Delete the heading "Safety Precautions" from the user manual, as this detracts from the Precautionary Statements. All statements about people, pets and children must conform to statements in the General Precautions and Restrictions.

Revise the statement "operate the fogger only in well ventilated areas" to read "operate the fogger outdoors only".

The fogger must bear the signal word, the statement "Keep out of Reach of Children", the EPA Reg. No. and Establishment No., and a reference to the accompanying label. These must be visible when the fogger is in use.

Warranty statements must be revised in accordance with guidance provided at <http://www.epa.gov/pesticides/regulating/labels/warranty.pdf>.

References to "outdoor games" must be qualified by the statement "Keep out of reach of children."

Optional Marketing Graphics may not detract from the Precautionary Statements or the directions for use.

The Burgess propane outdoor fogger is not approved for use with this registration, as a Burgess propane outdoor fogger user manual has not been submitted for review.

The basic confidential statement of formula (CSF) dated 5/4/07 and alternate CSFs dated 5/21/07 are acceptable and copies have been placed in the file jacket for this registration.

You are reminded of the requirement to report incidents under 40 CFR 152.125.

Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Use MULTICIDE® 29131 [Product Name] to rid your backyard of mosquitos that may carry West Nile Virus & Biting Flies including house flies, stable flies, black flies, and biting midges. Works in and around your garden, lawn, deck, patio, swimming pool, picnic area, or campsite. When used in Black Flag or Burgess thermal foggers, MULTICIDE® 29131 [Product Name] becomes a virtually odor-free fog that moves through the air to penetrate dense foliage to kill insects where they live and hide.

WHEN AND HOW TO FOG:

1. Fog in late afternoon or early dusk when wind is calm and insect activity is increasing. Do not treat if wind is greater than 5 mph because the fog will dissipate too quickly.
2. Pour MULTICIDE® 29131 [Product Name] undiluted into the Black Flag Insect Fogger or Burgess Bug Fogger. Refer to Fogger Instruction Booklet for proper use.
3. Fog at the rate of 1.5 oz per 1000 sq ft (a 25' x 40' area) [1.75 oz per 500 sq ft (a 25' x 20' area)]. For best results, thoroughly fog shrubs, groundcovers, and lawn areas surrounding the area you wish to occupy. Allow the fog to penetrate foliage where mosquitos and biting flies rest. Create a "fogged buffer zone" as your space allows. Apply one pump of the fogger every 3 to 4 seconds to obtain the best fog quality. It will take approximately 30 pumps to fog 1000 sq ft [15 pumps to fog 500 sq ft]. A 5,000 sq ft lawn and garden area can be treated in 10 minutes. 1 qt of product will be required to treat 1/2 acre. Refer to the Fogger Instruction Booklet for additional details.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL



The result is that more insecticide particles come in contact with a larger number of insects for greater kill and repelling, yet fogging uses far less insecticide than conventional sprays.

Where and When to Fog:

The **Black Flag® Bug Fogger** is designed to provide fast control of mosquitoes, flies and other flying pests in **outdoor** areas such as yards, patios, picnic areas, campgrounds and other places where insects can spoil **outdoor** living.

The ideal time to fog is around dusk, when the wind has usually died down and the temperature at ground level is somewhat higher than that of the air a few feet off the ground. This temperature inversion will tend to hold the fog in the treated area for a longer period of time. It is not advisable to attempt fogging when the wind is blowing more than five miles an hour, since the fog will be blown away before it has the opportunity to be effective.

Dryness or wetness of the fog is controlled by the rate of pumping. Pumping at the recommended rate of **once every 3 to 4 seconds** will produce the most effective fog. The fog should appear dense and white in color. If the fog appears to be thin or yellow in color you are pumping too slow.


Keep the fogger about 5 feet away from the object(s) being treated (plants / shrubs, furniture, or outdoor carpeting, etc.), since the oily residue could have damaging effects. Let the fog drift in the desired direction. At this distance, any non-vaporized particles of insecticide will have settled to the ground. **Always keep the breeze at your back when operating the fogger.**

▲ Safety Precautions:

- **Always wear protective clothing** (gloves, goggles).
- **Avoid breathing insecticide fog or vapors.**
- **Always pre-heat** your fogger for at least 2 minutes while keeping the fogger level to the ground. Failure to pre-heat may clog the burner orifice causing damage to the unit.
- **Use only Black Flag® Fogging Insecticide or Burgess Bug Killer Insect Fog.** Your Black Flag® Bug Fogger is designed to be used with these insecticides only. The use of other insecticides or chemicals may damage your fogger and could result in unsafe conditions thereby voiding the warranty.
- **Always** operate your fogger in an upright position. **Never turn the unit upside down.**
- **Do not over tighten the fuel valve.** Your fogger will continue to burn for a short while (up to 1 minute) after the valve is turned off. Over tightening may cause damage to your fogger.
- **Always inspect the threaded outlet of the propane fuel cylinder** and remove any dirt that may be there. Improper attachment of the propane gas cylinder to the fogger may result in a gas leak. Care must be taken not to cross thread when attaching the cylinder into the valve.
- Operate the fogger only in well ventilated areas. **DO NOT USE INDOORS** or within any enclosed structure. Always keep the fogger away from flammable materials. Do not smoke while filling and/or operating the unit. Do not fog near uncovered foods, cooking or eating utensils, or open fires. **Contamination, fire, or explosion could occur.**
- Do not operate the fogger in areas where people and pets are present. Keep the fogger, propane cylinder, and insecticide **out of the reach of children.**
- Keep your face, hands, and clothing away from the mesh burner cover at all times. The mesh burner cover becomes very hot while in operation.
- **Never** leave the fogger unattended while the burner is lit.
- **Always** follow the insecticide label instructions.
- **Never** store propane cylinders in living spaces or attached to the fogger. **Always** store them in a cool, well ventilated space. Propane cylinders are under high pressure. Do not handle them roughly.
- **Do not** incinerate the propane cylinder or insecticide container when empty. Propane cylinders and insecticide containers should be disposed of according to the manufacturer's label.

Preparing Your Fogger For Use

(Refer to diagram above)

Attaching the Propane Cylinder

Note: Use either 14.1oz "Tall" style or 16.4oz "Short" style propane cylinder.

- Always inspect the threaded outlet of the propane cylinder and remove any debris before attaching.
- Make sure the propane valve (E) is completely closed before attaching the propane cylinder (turn the propane valve fully clockwise).
- Insert the cylinder into the rear of the fogger (F).
- To avoid damage, be sure to properly align the threads of the propane cylinder with the threads of the fogger. Turn the propane cylinder clockwise to tighten.
- Hand tighten only. Over tightening propane cylinder may damage cylinder or fogger.

Filling the Insecticide Reservoir

Note: Use only Black Flag® Fogging Insecticide or Burgess Bug Killer Insect Fog. The use of other insecticides in the fogger can result in damage to the fogger or harm to the user. Do not use emulsifiable concentrates or other materials that are designed to be mixed with water. The use of other insecticides can clog the vapor coil of your fogger, making it unsafe or inoperable, and will void the warranty.

- Be sure the burner is not lit and the fogger is cool before filling the insecticide reservoir (D).
- Place the fogger on a flat, level, non-combustible, outdoor surface.
- Your fogger is equipped with a large insecticide reservoir fill spout (D).
- **Do not overfill** the reservoir. Insecticide may stain clothing and/or may be harmful to grass or foliage.
- Be sure to secure the reservoir cap before use.

Operating Your Fogger

Lighting

Note: Follow the instructions in "Preparing Your Fogger" before proceeding.

- Always place the fogger on a flat, level, non-combustible outdoor surface while lighting.
- Open the propane valve (E) approximately ¼ turn counter-clockwise.
- Your Black Flag® Bug Fogger is equipped with an auto-ignite feature that allows for quick burner lighting with the simple push of a button. This feature is much like those used on propane gas grills. To use the auto-ignite feature, push the button (B) while the propane valve is in the "on" position until the burner is lit. The burner may or may not light the first time the button is depressed, depending on the wind and other conditions. Wait approximately 1-2 seconds after each push of the button. If the unit does not light after 5-6 times, turn the propane valve to the "off" position, wait approximately 30 seconds and then repeat the process with the valve returned to the "on" position.
** If the auto igniter should fail to work, go to the trouble-shooting page to see how to light manually **
- After successful ignition, allow the fogger to pre-heat for at least 2 minutes while keeping level to the ground. While pre-heating, some flame may appear around the mesh burner cover. This is normal and should not be a cause for concern (if the condition persists after the pre-heat period, do not use the fogger and immediately shut off the unit). Contact Customer Service (1-800-311-9903) before using again. **Failure to pre-heat the burner may clog the burner orifice causing damage to your fogger.**

Fogging

Note: You must pre-heat your fogger for at least 2 minutes prior to fogging.

- Squeeze the trigger (C) slowly and steadily approximately once every 3 to 4 seconds to obtain the most effective fog.
- Always keep the breeze at your back.
- If a flame should appear at the end of the nozzle, immediately stop pumping and close the propane valve (E). Place the fogger on a flat, non-combustible surface. The flame will stop after excess insecticide is dissipated. Contact Customer Service (1-800-311-9903) before using again.
- Keep the fogger about 5 feet from the area to be treated, and let the fog drift in the desired direction.
- Keep the hot mesh burner cover (A) away from skin and clothing.

Shutting Off Your Fogger


- Stop pumping the trigger.
- Be sure to wait for the unit to stop fogging **before** turning off the propane valve (E). Excess insecticide in the coil will take 1 to 2 minutes to vaporize.
- Turn the propane valve (E) clockwise to shut off the propane supply to the burner. ****DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN PROPANE VALVE****
- The flame may continue to burn for up to 1 minute after closing the propane valve (E). Be sure the flame is completely extinguished and the unit is cooled prior to storing it.

Storing Your Fogger



- Be sure the burner flame is completely extinguished and the mesh burner cover (A) is completely cooled.
- Remove the propane cylinder from the fogger and store in a cool, well ventilated area **out of the reach of children.**
- Store the unit flat on its base to avoid possible insecticide leakage.
- Store the fogger, insecticide, and propane cylinder **away from children.**
- When storing the unit for extended periods of time, be sure to start with fresh insecticide upon re-use.

Trouble Shooting Guide

Trouble: (Symptom)	Look For: (Probable Cause)	Remedy: (Corrective Action)
<p>No fog while until heats up Burner is working</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Nozzle and / or end of coil is obstructed or clogged. 2) Pump is plugged or inoperable. 3) Improper fogging material. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1a) Clean and / or remove any obstructions from the nozzle orifice. 1b) Remove carbon build-up from inside the coil by removing the nozzle and cleaning out the tip of the coil using a brush, piece of wire, or pipe cleaner. Be sure to reinstall the nozzle after cleaning. 2) Contact Customer Service at 1-800-311-9903. 3) Use only Black Flag® Fogging Insecticide or Burgess Bug Killer Insect Fog.
<p>No fog Burner is not operating properly</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Propane gas cylinder is low or empty. 2) Propane tank is attached improperly. 3) Burner assembly fails to light or will not stay lit. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Replace the propane cylinder. 2) Screw in the propane cylinder tightly. 3) Check the igniter. (See the next page under "Unit doesn't light")
<p>Dripping</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Nozzle is loose. 2) Excessive insecticide output. 3) Not at proper operating temperature. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Tighten the nozzle securely. 2) Pump at a slower rate. 3) Wait 10-15 seconds before pumping.
<p>Poor fog quality</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Improper fogging material. 2) If the fog is thin or yellowish, the pumping rate is too low. 3) If the fog is wet or dripping, the pumping rate is too high or the unit has not reached its proper operating temperature. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Use only Black Flag® Fogging Insecticide or Burgess Bug Killer Insect Fog. 2) Increase your pumping rate. 3a) Make sure the unit has been pre-heated for at least 2 minutes. 3b) Decrease your pumping rate

Trouble: (Symptom)	Look For: (Probable Cause)	Remedy: (Corrective Action)
Flare up / uncontrolled burning 	1) Insecticide ignited.	1) Stop pumping immediately. Turn the propane valve off. The flame will stop after excess insecticide is eliminated. Contact Customer Service at 1-800-311-9903.
Unit doesn't light 	1) Check propane. 2) Igniter not working.	1a) Be sure there is propane in the tank. 1b) Make sure the valve is open 1/4 turn. 2a) Replace the igniter Contact Customer Service at 1-800-311-9903 2b) Light the unit manually. Place lighter under the coil, then open the fuel valve 1/4 turn. Ignition will take place immediately. Should the gas blow the lighter out, turn off the gas and wait 30 seconds before trying to light again.
