In the directions for use, clarify whether the fogging is achieved by squeezing the trigger, pumping the fogger or pumping the trigger.

Delete the heading "Safety Precautions" from the user manual, as this detracts from the Precautionary Statements. All statements about people, pets, children, food and food utensils must conform to statements in the Precautionary Statements, Directions for Use, Storage and Disposal and General Precautions and Restrictions.

Revise the statement "operate the fogger only in well ventilated areas" to read "operate the fogger outdoors only".

The fogger must bear the signal word, the statement "Keep out of Reach of Children", the EPA Reg. No. and Establishment No., and a reference to the accompanying label. These must be visible when the fogger is in use.

Warranty statements must be revised in accordance with guidance provided at <u>http://www.epa.gov/pesticides/regulating/labels/warranty.pdf</u>.

References to "outdoor games" must be qualified by the statement "Keep out of reach of children."
