Subject: Notification per Pesticide Registration Notice 2007-4

The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 2007-4, dated April 20, 2010, for "Propoxur Technical Insecticide," EPA Registration Number 1021-1869.

The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for applicability under PRN 2007-4, and finds that the label changes requested do fall within the scope of PRN 2007-4. The label has been date-stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.



By Notification, we are updating the storage and disposal statement per PR-Notice 2004-7. This product is a manufacturing use product that is not diluted prior to use, therefore we have not added detailed rinsing instructions per §156.146. We have however, per Nancy Fitz' recommendation maintained our current instructions to triple rinse the container before disposing or offering for reconditioning or recycling. A copy of Nancy's recommendation is enclosed for your convenience.

Enclosed are two (2) copies of the label. One (1) copy has changes highlighted.

This amendment is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA." 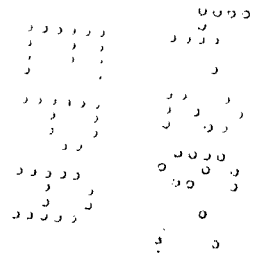

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning, even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
