2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 1021-2556"

b. Per the Agency's efficacy review (copy attached), delete (~~strike through text~~) or revise the following label claims as follows:

1. Delete "[~~Drives pests from hiding~~]."

2. Revise "[~~Kills pests where they hide: in . . .~~]" to "kills exposed pests where they hide: in . . ."

4. Delete "[~~Creates an invisible insect barrier~~]."

5. Revise "[~~Kills common crawling insects and aids in controlling nuisance flying insects~~]" to say "Kills listed crawling insects and aids in controlling listed nuisance flying insects."

6. Delete "[~~Helps prevent flies and mosquitoes from entering the home~~]."

7. Delete "[~~Controls flies and mosquitoes where they gather~~]."

Within sixteen (16) months of the date on this Notice of Registration, provide to the Agency acceptable data packages for Guideline Studies: OPPTS 830.6317, (Storage Stability), OPPTS 830.6320 (Corrosion Characteristics), and OPPTS 810.3500 (Product Performance Efficacy [for bed bugs, *Cimex lectularius*]). If acceptable data is not submitted within 16 months of this NOR, this registration will expire on February 26, 2011.

4. Submit two (2) copies of the finished labeling bearing the above stated revisions prior to releasing the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

CAUTION

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

MGK Formula 29321 is an effective formulation which kills crawling insects fast. It stays on treated surfaces and provides residual insect killing power for up to three months.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food handling surfaces.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed.

PRECAUTIONS: People and pets should not be allowed in treated areas until spray has dried. Do not use this product on pets. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Sprayer Instructions:

How to prime and care for your sprayer:

1. After shaking product well, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.
2. Turn sprayer nozzle one half turn counter-clockwise. Hold sprayer below the level of container and prime by pumping trigger 10-15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to fine spray or jet stream as needed.
3. To store, turn nozzle to "off" position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.

GENERAL: Apply as a coarse, wet spray to thoroughly treat hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas around pipes, under refrigerators, and along baseboards to control pests listed below. Spray directly on insects when possible. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until the spray has dried.

INDOORS:

For control of Carpet Beetles, thoroughly spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting; under carpeting, rugs and furniture; in closets; on shelving; and wherever else insects are seen or suspected.

Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.

To Kill Ants, German Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Psocids, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Waterbugs:

Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For Ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever these pests may find entrance.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: For Control of Brown Dog Ticks, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames; and localized areas of floors and floor coverings where these pests may be present. For control of Fleas, thoroughly apply a fine particle broadcast spray to infested rugs, carpets, and pet resting areas. Prior to treatment, aquariums and fish bowls should be covered, and birds, such as canaries, should be removed from the area. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Treat dogs and cats with a product registered for use on animals. Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

To Kill Bedbugs: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices and around baseboards, floorboards, headboards, and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs, then spot treat only areas that may harbor pests. On mattresses, concentrate on tufts, folds, and seams.

To Kill Carpenter Ants: Use a coarse spray around doors, doorframes, windows, and other areas where these ants enter the premises or hide. Spray into cracks and crevices, through openings or small, newly-drilled holes into wall voids where these ants or their nests are present.

Flies and Mosquitoes: For use only as an aid in controlling these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever insects may enter the room. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures, on porches, in garages, and other places where insects alight or congregate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in cool dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL AND CONTAINER HANDLING:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.
