The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Esfenvalerate Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for

shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Sprayer Instructions:

How to prime and care for your sprayer:

- 1. After shaking product well, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.
- 2. Turn sprayer nozzle one half turn counter-clockwise. Hold sprayer below the level of container and prime by pumping trigger 10-15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to fine spray or jet stream as needed.
- 3. To store, turn nozzle to "off" position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.

GENERAL: Apply as a coarse, wet spray to thoroughly treat hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas around pipes, under refrigerators, and along baseboards to control pests listed below. Spray directly on insects when possible. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until the spray has dried.

INDOORS:

<u>For control of Carpet Beetles</u>: Thoroughly spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting; under carpeting, rugs and furniture; in closets; on shelving; and wherever else insects are seen or suspected.

Note: Check carpet manufacturer's warranty and care and maintenance information before using product on your specific brand of carpeting.

To kill Ants, German Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, Psocids, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Waterbugs:

Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For Ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever these pests may find entrance.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: For Control of Brown Dog Ticks, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames; and localized areas of floors and floor coverings where these pests may be present. For control of Fleas, thoroughly apply a fine particle broadcast spray to infested rugs, carpets, and pet resting areas. Prior to treatment, aquariums and fish bowls should be covered, and birds, such as canaries, should be removed from the area. Do not permit humans or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Treat dogs and cats with a product registered for use on animals. Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application.

<u>To kill Bed Bugs:</u> Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices and around baseboards, floorboards, headboards, and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs, then spot treat only areas that may harbor pests. On mattresses, concentrate on tufts, folds, and seams.

<u>To kill Carpenter Ants</u>: Use a coarse spray around doors, doorframes, windows. and other areas where these ants enter the premises or hide. Spray into cracks and crevices, through openings or small, newly-drilled holes into wall voids where these ants or their nests are present.

<u>Flies and Mosquitoes</u>: For use only as an aid in controlling these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, or wherever insects may enter the room. Also spray surfaces around light fixtures, on porches, in garages, and other places where insects alight or congregate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
