- a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 1021-2558"
- b. Make the following label revisions:

Product Name comment(s):

1. Change the word "Pyrethrum" to "Pyrethrins" within the product name for the proposed product, so that the brand name would read "MGK<sup>®</sup> Pyrethrins 50%."

First Aid section comment(s):

2. Revise the 1<sup>st</sup> bullet found within the "IF SWALLOWED:" to read "Immediately call a poison control center or doctor."

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

3. Revise the existing subsection to read "Contains Petroleum Distillate. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes and gloves."

8. Revise the existing "PESTICIDE STORAGE:" subsection to read "Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals."
9. Revise the existing "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" subsection to read "Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Offer for recycling if available for reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities."
