Not for formulation into granular End-Use Products.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such use(s). Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Handling: Nonrefillable Container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying and offer for recycling, if available or reconditioning, if appropriate or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and Local procedures.

[Optional Wording for Refillable Containers]

[Container Handling: Refillable containers. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times.]
