- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated are until sprays have dried.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.

Be sure to treat pet bedding, as this is a primary hiding place for fleas, ticks, and their eggs. No need to remove pet bedding after treatment. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Use a registered flea control product on your pets in conjunction with this treatment. Allow all surfaces to dry before use.

[ALTERNATE Flea USE INSTRUCTIONS No. 2]:

FOR [FLEAS &] TICKS IN BUILDINGS: [Hold product 36" above floor and] Apply in infested areas of pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, behind baseboards, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Treat higher cracks such as upper door jams and window framing, behind pictures where females may crawl to lay eggs. Do not use directly on pets. Simultaneously treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets prior to pet's entry into treated areas.

BED BUGS: Thoroughly inspect area of suspected bed bug infestation and note potential harborage sites or actual infestations. Remove and /or pick up clothing and other obstacles that may prevent thorough inspection or treatment. Remove and sanitize infested bedding (pillows and linens), clothing, or other items. Apply on mattresses as a spot treatment to mattress seams, edges, buttons, and tufts of bed only. Do not use directly on pillows, bed linens, or clothes. Bed Bugs may also harbor in areas of the room away from the bed. Hold can 2 to 3 feet from surface to be treated. Remove all clothes and other articles from dressers or closets before application. Take bed apart. Treat joints and channels if hollow, such as square or round

tubing and see that interior framework is treated. Allow all treated areas to dry thoroughly before use.

This product is not recommended for use as a sole protection against bed bugs. If evidence of bed bugs is found in/on mattresses, use this product as part of an integrated pest management program to control bed bugs.

<u>DUST MITES:</u> Spray with a sweeping motion to surfaces where mites congregate such as mattresses, box springs, headboard, floors, carpeting, and baseboard. Spray surfaces until damp. Apply on mattresses as a spot treatment to mattress seams, edges, buttons, and tufts of bed only. Do not use directly on pillows, bed linens, or clothes. Do not saturate the mattress and do not treat entire surface area of mattress. Allow mattress to dry thoroughly before replacing pillows and or bed linens.

After mattress is dry, cover with mattress cover and sheet. Do not use mattress without a cover. Vacuum entire area once dry. Since vacuuming stirs dust up in the air, those with allergies should have another person vacuum or should wear a dust mask and use vacuum with a high efficiency particulate (HEPA) filter.]

<u>CARPET BEETLES (Black, Furniture, Varied):</u> Apply with a sweeping motion as a surface spray to carpet, rugs, closets, baseboards, upholstered furniture, and around edges of carpet. Contact as many insects as possible. Spray into cracks and crevices where insects harbor, live and breed. Apply around

cartons, containers, and furniture where these insects tend to congregate. Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

LICE [and (lice eggs)(louse eggs)]: Spray only surfaces that cannot be laundered or dry-cleaned including mattresses and upholstered furniture. Do not use on sheets or pillowcases. Apply on mattresses as a spot treatment to mattress seams, edges, buttons, and tufts of bed only. Do not use directly on pillows, bed linens, or clothes. Do not saturate the mattress and do not treat entire surface area of mattress. Allow mattress to dry thoroughly before replacing pillows and/or bed linens.

[ALTERNATE Lice and Lice Eggs USE INSTRUCTIONS No. 2]:

[TO KILL LICE AND LICE EGGS: Do Not use on humans or animals. Treat an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect after drying. Then treat entire area.
