Not for use on horses intended for human consumption.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Do not make applications during rain.

Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply to pets. Remove birds and other pets before application. Cover any water inhabited by fish (such as aquariums and ornamental fish ponds) during treatment, and turn aquarium systems off.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.

To protect horses, foals, and ponies from Mosquitoes, Stable Flies, House Flies, and Deer Ticks that may transmit Lyme Disease.

PREPARATION:

Thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation for show grooming, clean the coat with a good cleansing shampoo. Wait until the coat is completely dry before applying

For initial treatment, liberally apply [this spray] for best results. Reapply every 5 to 7 days under normal conditions for initial applications. As infestation subsides and protection builds, repeat treatment every 10 to 14 days or as prescribed by a veterinarian. Reapply every time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain.

<u>Wipe-On</u>:

For horse's face, always apply as a wipe. Apply liberally with a piece of clean, absorbent cloth, toweling (Turkish) or sponge.

Ready-to-Use Spray:

Cover entire surface of animal with spray. Avoid getting spray into horse's eyes, nose or mouth. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Direct the spray to the legs, shoulders, and neck where pests appear or tend to congregate. Apply directly onto attached ticks. Brush coat against the grain while spraying to insure adequate penetration of the product.

Make sure spray has dried before covering with any tack.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant, or nursing animals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry place, preferably a locked storage area. Store above freezing. Store with container tightly closed. Store away from food and pet food. Avoid contamination of food, feed, and domestic water supplies.

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.
