

Non food/non-feed areas area areas such as garbage rooms lavatories floor drains (to sewers) entries and vestibules offices locker rooms machine rooms boiler rooms garages mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling)

Food/feed areas include areas for receiving storage packing (canning bottling wrapping and boxing) preparing edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills dairies edible oils and syrups) Serving areas are also considered a food/feed area when food is exposed and facility is in operation

Do not apply bait to areas where food utensils or food preparation surfaces may become contaminated Care should be taken to avoid depositing gel onto exposed surfaces.
