2. You must generate a one year storage stability and corrosion characteristics study corresponding to guideline 830.6317 on the proposed product. It is required that the observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 month intervals. The results must be submitted to the Agency in electronic and hard copy format.

3. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA Section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data, and submit acceptable responses required for registration review of your product under FIFRA.

4. Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. If you fail to comply with all of the **Terms of Registration** stated above, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) and/or automatically expire. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes your acceptance of these conditions.

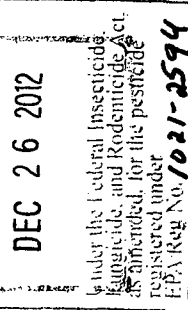
