(FOR SPOT TREATMENT) TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, AND SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried.

<u>Carpet Beetles [Dermestids (Trogoderma)]</u>: Directly spray insects. Where insects are present, bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed using a spot treatment. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, on floors and walls, around windowsills and baseboards, and wherever these insects are seen. Backing of carpets and rugs should be allowed to dry before re-laying on floor.

[ALTERNATE Carpet Beetle USE INSTRUCTIONS No. 2]:

<u>CARPET BEETLES</u> (Black, Furniture, Varied): Apply as a spot treatment to carpet, rugs, closets, baseboards, upholstered furniture, and around edges of carpet. Contact insects directly. Spray into cracks and crevices where insects harbor, live and breed. Apply around cartons, containers, and furniture where these insects tend to congregate. Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found. Insects must be contacted directly.

<u>Foraging Ants and Foraging Carpenter Ants</u>: To kill foraging Ants (excluding Fire Ants), including Black Carpenter Ants, spray insects directly and on ant trails.

TO KILL BED BUGS: Apply on and around bed frames, headboards, floors, carpeting, baseboards, furniture, moldings, ceiling, and walls. For infested mattresses, apply to tufts, folds, edges, sides, and seams until moist. Allow to dry before remaking bed. For infested furniture, apply only to tufts, seams, folds, and edges. Do not apply to surfaces where prolonged human contact will occur. Also for spot treatment of luggage, closets, drapes and other window or wall appointments.

[Take bed apart. Treat joints and channels if hollow, such as square or round tubing, and treat the interior framework. Treat tufts, folds, and edges of mattresses. Cover mattresses before use. Allow mattresses to dry thoroughly and cover with clean bedding before using. Bedbugs

Insects must be contacted directly.]

[Bedbugs: Spray tufts, folds and seams of mattresses. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Spray to the point of dampness, but not run-off. After mattress is dry, cover with mattress cover and sheet. Do not use mattress without cover. Retreat if infestation occurs. Insects must be contacted directly.]

[Bedbugs: Spray tufts, folds and seams of mattresses. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. After mattress is dry, cover with mattress cover and sheet. Do not use mattress without a cover. Retreat if infestation occurs. Insects must be contacted directly.]

Apply as a crack-and-crevice or spot application where bed bugs are present. This includes bed frames, box springs, inside empty drawers and clothes closets, night stands and other furniture in the room, carpet edges, high and low wall moldings (such as floor molding or window casings), wall voids, behind wall hangings and mirrors, wall paper edges and popcorn ceilings. Remove all clothes and other articles from dressers or closets before application. Take bed apart. Treat joints and channels if hollow, such as square or round tubing and see that interior framework is treated. Allow all treated areas to dry thoroughly before use. Insects must be contacted directly.

This product is not recommended for use as a sole protection against bed bugs. If evidence of bed bugs is found in/on mattresses, use this product as part of an integrated pest management program to control bed bugs.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly spray, as a spot treatment, infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests are present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.
