Restrictions for Indoor Uses

- Do not use water-based sprays in conduits, motor housing, junction boxes, switch boxes, or other electrical because of possible shock hazards.
- During any indoor surface application, do not allow dripping or runoff to occur. During any application to ceilings of a structure, cover surface below with plastic shielding or similar materials.

Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Millipedes, Earwigs, and Centipedes: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may be found or where they may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations. Refer to barrier treatment disactions to prevent infestation.
