The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Cypermethrins Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. FOR RESIDUAL PEST CONTROL IN AND ON buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. PERMITTED AREAS OF USE INCLUDE industrial buildings, houses, apartment buildings, laboratories, greenhouses, and the non-food/feed areas of stores, warehouses, vessels, railcars, trucks, trailers, schools, nurseries, day camps, lath houses, seed houses, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, laboratories and hospitals. INDOORS

Restrictions for Indoor Uses

- Do not use water-based sprays in conduits, motor housing, junction boxes, switch boxes, or other electrical because of possible shock hazards
- During any indoor surface application, do not allow dripping or runoff to occur. During any application to ceilings of a structure, cover surface below with plastic shielding or similar materials.
- Do not apply this product in any room being used as a living, eating, or recovery area by patients the elderly, or the infirm when they are in the room.
- Do not apply to classrooms when in use.
- Do not apply to areas of institutions (including libraries, sport facilities, etc.) when occupants are present in the immediate treatment area
- Do not use as a space spray.
- Use only in well-ventilated areas.
- Do not use concentrate or emulsion in fogging equipment.
- Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments which includes areas for receiving, serving, storage (dry, cold, frozen, raw), packaging (canning bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing (cleaning, slicing, cooking, grinding), edible waste storage, enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups), In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.
- Do not use in warehouses while raw agricultural commodities for food or feed, and/or raw or cured tobacco are being stored.
- Do not use in greenhouses where crops for food or feed are grown.
- Do not apply to pets. Remove birds and other pets before application. Cover any water inhabited by fish (such as aquariums and ornamental fish ponds) during treatment, and turn aquarium systems off.

Cockroaches, Spiders, Crickets, Silverfish and Firebrats: Apply as a coarse, low pressure spray to areas where these pests hide, such as baseboards, corners, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, attics and eaves, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks, furnaces, and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and similar areas. Pay particular attention to cracks and crevices.

Ants: To kill ants within buildings and homes, spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants where possible.

Carpenter Ants: Make spot applications as a spray to any trails, around doors and windows, wall voids, crawl spaces, and other places where ants enter premises. Where possible, treat ant nest or infested wood directly.

Wasps, Hornets, Yellowjackets, Bees: Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, especially under attic rafters, contacting as many insects as possible.

Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Millipedes, Earwigs, and Centipedes: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may be found or where they may enter premises. Spray baseboards, storage areas and other locations. Refer to barrier treatment directions to prevent infestation.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths: Apply directly to walls, ceilings, window screens, and other flying insect resting areas as a residual surface treatment. May be used inside residential buildings as well as in and around carports, garages, and storage sheds.

TO CONTROL *Fleas and Ticks:* Apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **Do not treat pets with this product.**

OUTDOORS

SPRAY DRIFT ADVISORIES

• Take precautions to minimize spray drift.

Restrictions for Outdoor Uses

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- 2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
- 3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
- 4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- 5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
- 6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.
 - Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size. (for example 2 ft by 1. Ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft).=
 - Do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.
 - Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.
 - Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.
 - Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.
 - Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.
 - Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-andcrevice treatment.
 - Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.
 - Treat surfaces to ensure th0orough coverage but avoid runoff.
 - To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

All outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors and eaves) are limited to spot treatments or crack-and-crevice applications, only.

Do not apply directly to or near water, storm drains, gutters, sewers, or drainage ditches. Do not apply when windy. Do not water the treated area(s) to the point of run-off or apply when raining or when rain is expected that day. Rinse application equipment over treated area only.

Ants, Bees, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Firebrats, Millipedes, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Wasps, Hornets, Yellowjackets. Apply as a residual spray to surfaces of buildings, porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, lawns, refuse dumps, garages in either hand or power sprayer. Treat other areas where these pests are found.

TO CONTROL *Fleas and Ticks:* Apply Cyper-Active to areas where fleas and ticks are most likely to be found, such as, but not limited to, dog houses, kennels runways, cracks-and-crevices in sidewalks, paths or patios where pests may rest.

BARRIER TREATMENT: To help prevent infestation of buildings, apply to a band of soil and vegetation 7 feet or less around and adjacent to the building. Also, treat the building foundation to a height of 2 feet where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply as a coarse spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the band area, using 77.5 ounces of 0.2% spray mix (155 ounces of 0.1% spray mix) per 1000 square feet.

APPLICATIONS TO LAWNS AND OTHER TURF GRASS SITES

When applying to lawns, gardens, ornamentals, and other landscape sites, apply at a maximum rate of 77.5 ounces of 0.2% diluted product per 1000 sq. ft. (0.44 lbs. a.i./Acre (0.0101 lbs. a.i.1000 ft²) or 155 ounces of 0.1% diluted product per 1000 sq. ft.

APPLICATIONS NEAR SWIMMING POOLS

This product may be applied as a broadcast treatment to lawns and other vegetated areas around swimming pools, or as a spot treatment or crack-and-crevice treatment to impermeable surfaces (such as tiled walkways) around pools. Do not apply directly to swimming pools or swimming pool systems.

APPLICATIONS IN AND ON BOATS

Do not apply to boat surfaces which contact water. Broadcast applications to exterior surfaces of boats are prohibited. Spot treatments may be made to exterior surfaces that do not contact water. Use inside boats, ships, and other vessels is permitted. Do not allow product to drain or wash off into water bodies or other aquatic habitat.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures.
