

Application to ornamental plants, flowers, shrubs and trees.

Pest Control Indoors (Indoor Non-Food): Crack and crevice, spot and general surface treatments in and around residential and non-residential buildings and structures including, but not limited to, the non-food areas of food-handling establishments, apartment buildings, bakeries, bottling facilities, breweries, cafeterias, food manufacturing plants, food service establishments, granaries and grain mills, hospitals, hotels, houses (including crawl spaces), industrial buildings, kitchens, laboratories, mausoleums, mobile and motor homes, offices, restaurants, schools, stores, warehouses, wineries, and vehicles.

Repeat this procedure two more times.

Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.
