For best results in controlling Tick infestations, locate ticks and spray directly on them. Avoid spraying face and genitals. An application of 30 to 45 seconds is usually sufficient for an average size dog, for cats about 10 seconds is adequate or 1 second per lb. of body weight of the cat or dog. Repeat application weekly if necessary.

To control infestation in kennels or sleeping quarters, after treating animals as directed, spray bedding, walls, cracks, crevices, and flooring. Always remove infested bedding before spraying in kennels or sleeping quarters.
