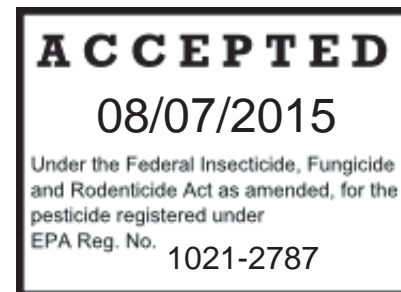

Each disc consists of two (2) coils that should be separated

Loosen outer rings until end moves freely. Grasp each comma shaped portions in the center between thumb and forefinger of each hand. Separate the two comma shaped portions by gently pressing them in opposite directions 1 inch apart.

Hold one comma shaped end and shake lightly or gently pry apart to separate the coils. Insert top of the coil stand into slot in comma shaped end of coil. Light outer end of coil until glowing. Blow out any flame. Do not touch glowing end.

Place coils 10 feet apart around area to be protected.

For best results do not use in windy areas.

Coil burns 5-7 hours in still air.

If shorter periods of use are desired, break coil into appropriate length and place in notched cut of holder

Directions for separating coils and use of burner.

Each disc consists of two (2) coils that should be separated.

1. Remove one Comma shaped coil from the enclosed protective wrapping.
2. Light outer end of Comma coil until glowing / blow out flame. Do not touch glowing end.
3. Place the Comma shaped coil onto the stem in the base of the Mosquito Coil Burner. Lightly twist the coil so the stem fits into slot at the center end of the coil.
4. [[Place the lid back onto Mosquito Coil Burner.] Optional Metal Burner does not have lid]
5. Place the Mosquito Coil Burner in area away from children.
6. Use four mosquito coils per 100 square feet.
7. Place additional Mosquito Coil Burners 10 feet apart around area to be protected.
8. For best results do not use in windy areas. Coil burns 5-7 hours in still air.
9. If shorter periods of use are desired, break coil into appropriate length and place in burner on raised surfaces.

[MOSQUITO REPELLENT STICKS

[Brand Name] Mosquito Sticks help repel mosquitoes in confined areas outdoors. It is useful in places where there is little or no breeze such as patios, porches, picnic areas, and campsites.

[Optional Directions for use for Mosquito Sticks]

Remove [Brand Name] Mosquito Stick from box. Ignite tip until it flames. Invert to further ignite body of the stick.

When this occurs, blow out flame.

It will now burn without flame and create a smoke to repel mosquitoes.

Place bottom end of stick into ground.

Do not touch glowing end.

Place PIC Mosquito Stick about 10 feet apart.

Use four PIC Mosquito sticks per 100 square feet.

To extinguish, gently knock off glowing tip and extinguish tip into dirt or sand. Note: If crack appears in body of sticks, this is normal and in no way impedes its effectiveness.]

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food or pet food.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling
