Poor Copy

Do not pasture dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter on treated areas.

SOYBEANS: For control of armyworm, bean-leaf beetles, corn earworm, crickets, flea beetles, grasshoppers, green cloverworm, lesser corn-stalk borer, southern green stinkbugs, thrips, velvetbean caterpillar, and webworms, mix 5 pints of TONAPHENE-6 in 3 to 5 gallons of water and apply to one acre.

Aircraft Application: Add 5 pints Tonaphene-6 to 1 gallon DD F-2 in 100 gallons of water and apply to one acre.

Do not make more than two applications after pods form.  
Do not treat within 21 days of harvest. Do not feed treated plants or ensilage made from treated plants to poultry, dairy animals, or animals being finished for slaughter. Do not feed Soybean mill trash to livestock or poultry.

Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.
