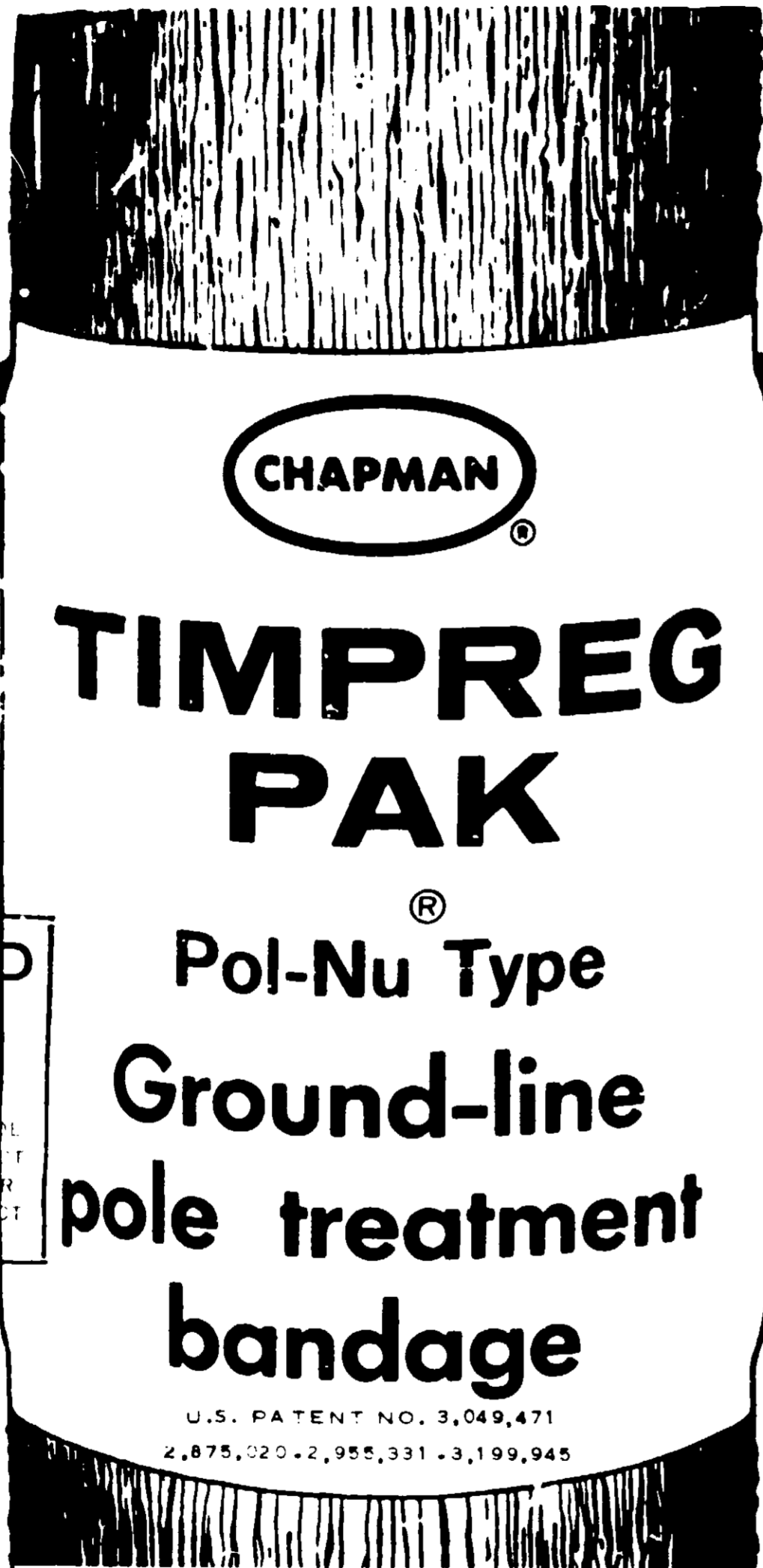

HOW TO APPLY CHAPMAN TIMPREG PAK

1. Remove earth from around pole to a depth of 18 inches.
2. Use a steel brush to remove dirt and loose, decayed wood. Clean pole well
3. Inspect pole for extent of decay. If found to be sub-standard it should be replaced.
4. If left in place, apply opened Timpreg Pak by wrapping it around pole with preservative

5. Back-fill and tamp dirt firmly, mounding within an inch of bandage top. Do not pile back-fill above top edge of Timpreg Pak.
