### INGREDIENT STATEMENT

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE Termite Control

Mix 1 gallon Aldrec in 95 gallons of water. Apply the resulting 0.5% emulsion as follows:

**General Application -**  
Treatment shall not be made when the soil or fill is excessively wet or immediately after heavy rains, to avoid surface flow of the toxicant from application site. Unless the treated areas are to be immediately covered, precautions shall be taken to prevent disturbance of the treatment by human or animal contact with the treated soil.

**Slab-on-Ground Construction**  
Apply an over-all treatment under entire surface of floor slab including porch floors and entrance platforms. Apply at rate of 1 gallon per 10 square feet, except that if fill under slab is gravel or other coarse absorbent material, apply at rate of 1½ gallons per 10 square feet.

Apply to critical areas, to a depth of 1 foot, along both sides of foundation wall, along interior foundation walls, and around plumbing at a rate of 4 gallons per 10 lineal feet. Chemical shall be mixed with the soil as it is being replaced in the trench.

Voids of unit masonry foundation walls, apply to void at or near bottom of foundation at rate of 2 gallons per 10 lineal feet.

**Basement or Crawl-Space Construction**  
Apply to critical areas along foundation walls, around piers and under slabs of porches and entrance platforms.

Apply at a rate of 4 gallons per 10 lineal feet along both sides of foundation walls, piers, etc. Chemical shall be mixed with the soil as it is being replaced in the trench.

- (a) Where concrete foundations without cracks are used, apply to depth of 1 foot.
- (b) Where concrete foundations with cracks or masonry are involved, a minimum 30 inch trench should be used and the chemical applied at rate of 4 gallons per 5 linear feet of trench.

Voids of unit masonry foundation walls and piers, apply to void at or near bottom of foundation at rate of 2 gallons per 10 lineal feet. Under porch floors and entrance platforms, apply overall treatment at the rate of 1 gallon per 10 square feet. Where finished rooms are provided in basements or below-grade areas, apply an over-all treatment to basement floor at rate of 1 gallon per 10 square feet.
