



WEED-FREE G

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A granular, non-selective weed and grass killer. For dry application only.

GENERAL

WEED-FREE G is a non-flammable, non-volatile, free-flowing granular product. It is designed to be applied as is from seed or fertilizer applicator type equipment to the soil at the rates suggested for control of weeds and grasses.

WEED-FREE G is intended for use on utility, highway, railroad and pipeline right-of-ways, around lumber yards, power substations, railroad trestles, unpaved parking lots, driveways, drainage ditchbanks, fence rows, farm buildings and implement or equipment storage yards and similar non-crop areas where control of all vegetative growth is desired.

Application as directed will result in loss of soil productivity for an extended period.

Best results are obtained from application uniform in spread and of the proper quantity. It is, therefore, desirable to remove heavy growth that would interfere with uniformity of spread and to check the application rate to make certain that the correct amount is being applied.

WEED-FREE G can control unwanted vegetation only by being absorbed into the roots. As WEED-FREE G is applied only to the surface of the soil, it must be moved into the soil by rainfall to be effective. Therefore, results will come sooner if WEED-FREE G is applied during the late winter, spring, or early summer months when rain may normally be expected. WEED-FREE G is slow in action, unwanted vegetation will gradually wither and die as the chemical is absorbed into the roots and complete kill is effected.

DIRECTIONS

While WEED-FREE G is designed to give residual control, treated areas should be examined periodically and re-treatments made as necessary. Generally such re-treatments made will need to be done on a spot basis only.

Annual Weeds, Grasses and Vines: Apply 1 pound of WEED-FREE G per 100 square feet of affected area.

Perennial Grasses, Weeds and Vines: Apply 2 pounds of WEED-FREE G per 100 square feet where deep-rooted perennial grasses and vines such as Johnson grass, Bermuda grass, Trumpet Vine and brambles are present.

NOTE

Proper quantities of WEED-FREE G may be measured using a one-pound coffee can, a one quart oil can, or a one-gallon paint can. One level coffee can will contain approximately one and two-thirds (1.66) pounds of WEED-FREE G; one level quart oil can will contain approximately one and two-thirds (1.66) pounds of WEED-FREE G and one level gallon paint can will contain approximately six and one-third (6.33) pounds of WEED-FREE G.

Do not get onto areas which may be underlaid by roots of adjacent valuable growth, as WEED-FREE G may injure or kill such growth.

WARNING (Continued)

Do not apply to areas such as severe slopes from which heavy rainfall may wash the WEED-FREE G onto soil occupied by valuable plants, or into domestic or irrigation waters. Avoid contamination of domestic or irrigation waters.

Do not use on walks, driveways, tennis courts, or similar areas.

Application equipment must be thoroughly cleaned after every use. Do not use equipment for applying WEED-FREE G for application of seeds, insecticides, herbicides, or fertilizers as it may contaminate them and injure or kill desirable plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

GENERAL: Consult Federal, State or Local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.
