APPLICATION TO POLES

POL-NU 15-15 care best by applied a goles on using the Character POL-NU EAN DAGE MAKER and POL-NU paper For application to deep checks in poles or the left fill a caulking gun with POL-NU 15-15 and apply Any grease equipment that with LT die No 2 cup grease will work with POL-NU 15-15.

Excavate the soil away from the poles to a depth of about 18 inches. Wire brush the pole surface to remove adhering soil. Scrape off any decay on the surface, this also desirable to take increment borrings directed towards the center of the pole. Holes should be plugged with tocust plugs or likeated wood plugs if decay is present in the center of the pole, consideration should be given to its early replacement or stubbing.

POL-NU 15-15 will penetrate wet wood it is not necessary to leave excavated poles exposed in order to dry out.

POUND 15-15 should be applied in a 174 inchillinchiess. More may be request 15 is special conditions.
