DIRECTIONS

PENTA GENERAL WEED KILLER is a contact herbicide useful for controlling types of weeds. As such, it kills the above ground vegetation properly sprayed with the entire leaf and stem surfaces. It is not intended to be controlled by soil activity. It is a spray. This is a herbicide between 9.5 and 10 gallons of spray per acre, depending upon the height and density of the vegetation.

Shallow-rooted annual weeds that are thoroughly sprayed will generally be completely killed. Perennial weeds will be killed to the ground, but in many cases will re-sprout. In areas of low rainfall, control will be good if the weeds are sprayed when they are full size and when the time of year rainfall begins. Repeated spraying will be shown with appears from seeds germinating later in the year to a growth of established weeds may be necessary in order to achieve desired control.

PENTA GENERAL WEED KILLER is intended for use on non-crop plants such as right-of-ways, around lumber yards, sawmills, power substation, storage areas and incinerator plant sites, on drainage ditch banks, fence rows and similar areas where control of most vegetative growth is desired.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Use oil resistant synthetic rubber tubes and gaskets. Wash your hands thoroughly with water and a synthetic detergent such as Dettol, Vel, Fab, et al. before eating or other purposes for do not use for drinking water or other purposes.

Either cone or fan nozzle may be used for applications. For best results when it is best to use a fan nozzle. A pressure of at least 20 psi and one inch to aid in reaching the leaves of the weeds. Spray in a direction that causes the spray to fall on the weeds.

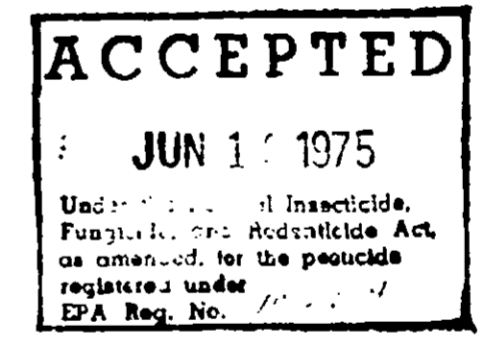
