WEED-FREE ACB-8P is a Nonselective herbicide for noncrop land such as industrial plant sites, rights-of-way, lumber yards, petroleum tank farms and similar areas where complete control of all vegetation is desired.

WEED-FREE ACB-8P is effective when applied before or after weeds emerge. The weed-killing process begins when rainfall moves the herbicide down into the root zone where it is absorbed by the roots of existing weeds or later germinating seeds. Since the chemical enters plants through the roots, its effectiveness is dependent on rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone. Very dry soil conditions and lack of rainfall may result in poor weed control.

GENERAL WEED AND GRASS CONTROL

For annual broadleaf weeds and grasses: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 lb. per 100 sq. ft. of soil surface.

For perennial broadleaf weeds and grasses: Apply 1/2 to 1 lb. per 100 sq. ft. of soil surface. Use a higher rate when deep-rooted perennials are present. Some control may be obtained with rainfall and a long growing season. For complete control is desired.

WEED-FREE ACB-8P can be applied by hand or mechanical spreader of any size and density. They are especially suited for large spray equipment to reach. In these cases, a cycle spreader may be used. For large spreaders and "air blast" applications, apply quickly and uniformly.

Important: Use only for complete control of weeds and grasses on rights-of-way, lumber yards, petroleum tank farms, around farm buildings, and similar areas. Applied to the soil, it inhibits all plant growth. Do not use on areas where adjacent desirable plants might be injured.

They are especially practical in areas too small for large spray equipment and in areas that are hard to reach. In these cases, a cyclone type sander or fertilizer spreader may be used. For large areas, power-operated spreaders and dust applicators will distribute the pellets evenly and uniformly.

Important. Use only in areas where complete control of all vegetation is desired, such as industrial sites, rights-of-way, lumberyards, petroleum tank farms, around farm buildings, along fence lines, and similar areas. When applied to the soil, this product usually inhibits all plant growth for a year or more. Do not use on land to be cropped or where adjacent desirable trees, shrubs, or plants might be injured.
