STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed Drink milk, eggwhite or if these are not available, one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If in eyes Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wear natural rubber gloves and eye goggles when handling this product.

PQ-C is a concentrated wood preservative for use only on structural wood. Diluted with water for use, it protects wood from decay and termite attack. The need for wood protection depends upon the severity of service conditions and the desired durability. Like all wood preservatives, the degree of protection that PQ-C affords is dependent upon the amount retained in the wood and the depth of penetration.

Where termite infestation already exists, wood replacement and treatment is the most reliable means for control.

Treatment of dry wood generally is desirable. Since PQ-C which is water soluble as applied, turns water insoluble in the wood, it is practical to treat green wood although the treatment uniformity is lower with most species.

PQ-C can be applied to wood by brush, spray, dip or pressure treatment.

ABOVE GROUND USE: dilute 1 gallon PQ-C with 20 to 40 gallons of water depending upon service conditions. May be applied by brush or spray, but a 3 to 10 minute dip provides more reliable wood coverage. Reinspect annually for evidence of termite attack and retreat as necessary.
